Broquet brilliance for more bhp

Broquet in 1941, it was installed in the British Hurricane fighter aircraft engines that were posted to Russia. The product came about after the fuel available in Russia proved incompatible with the Hurricane's engine and therefore modifications to the fuel were necessary.

Broquet comes in the form of pellets made from different

metals that when in contact with fuel, diesel or oil, improves combustion. Each pellet lasts for 400,000km. It also removes and then inhibits the build-up of carbon deposits, waxes and gums that normally form in the combustion chamber. The result is more power or improved fuel economy, less maintenance, and a significant reduction in exhaust emissions.
